- *Arrest ↓*
- *First Appearance ↓*
- *District Court bond hearing ↓*
- *District Court probable cause hearing ↓*
- *Formal indictment presented to grand jury ↓*
- *[One Superior Court bond hearing could take place anytime from this point through the trial stage.]*
- *Superior Court "1st setting" or "2nd setting" in administrative court ↓*
- *Superior Court "plea conference" in administrative court ↓*
- *Superior Court "plea slot"/arraignment in administrative court ↓*
- *If pleads guilty, judge sentences defendant. If pleads not guilty, case scheduled for a trial docket*
